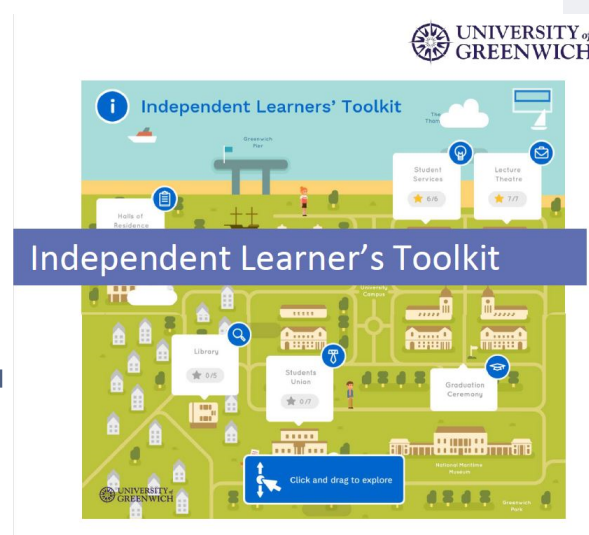




A skills course for students in their first year of higher education studies:

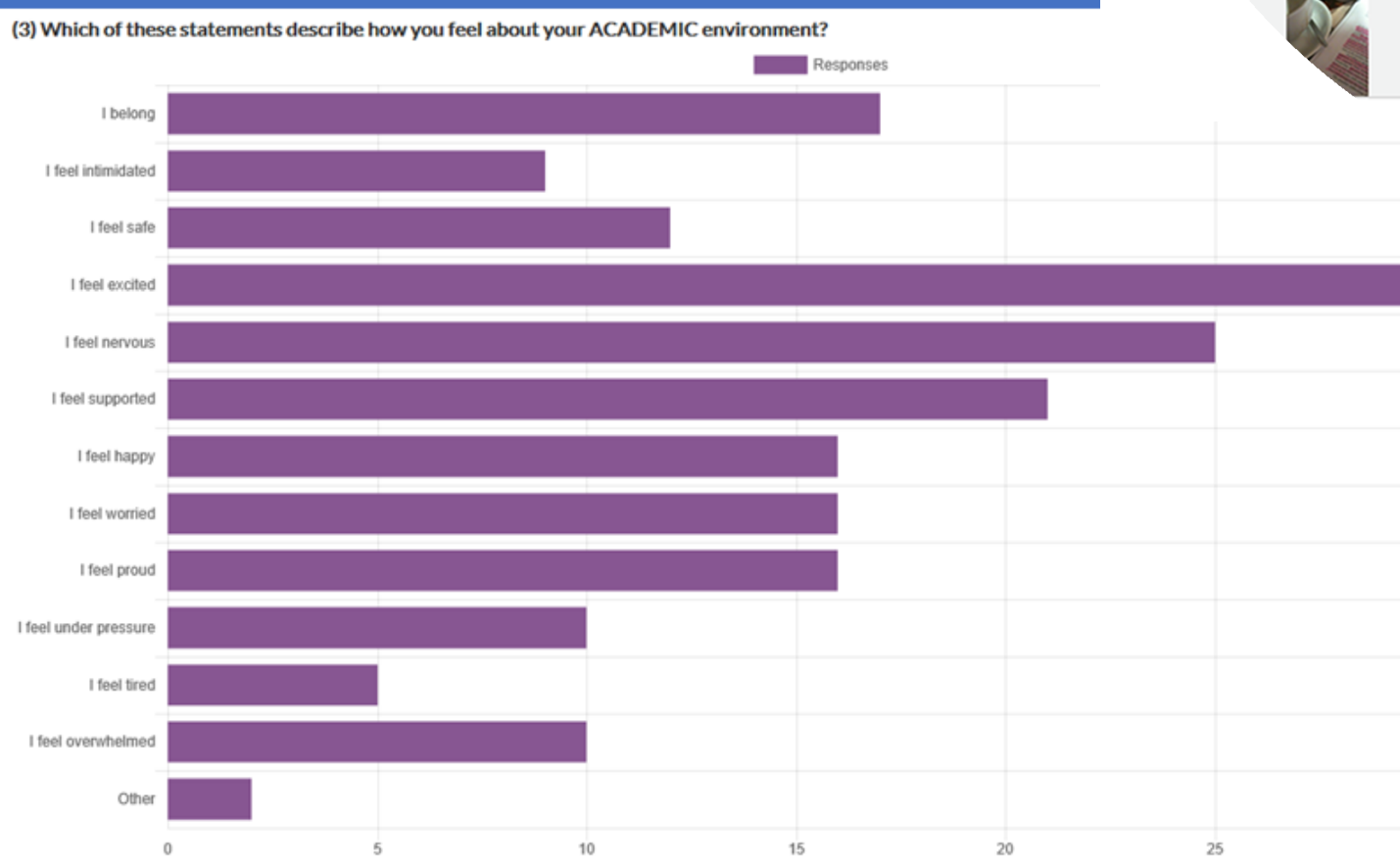
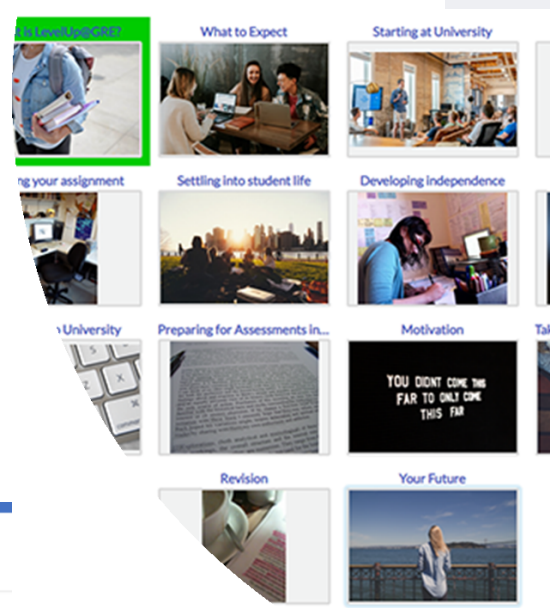

Students can engage with the course on their own, at their own pace or personal tutors refer specific sections or activities for students to do.



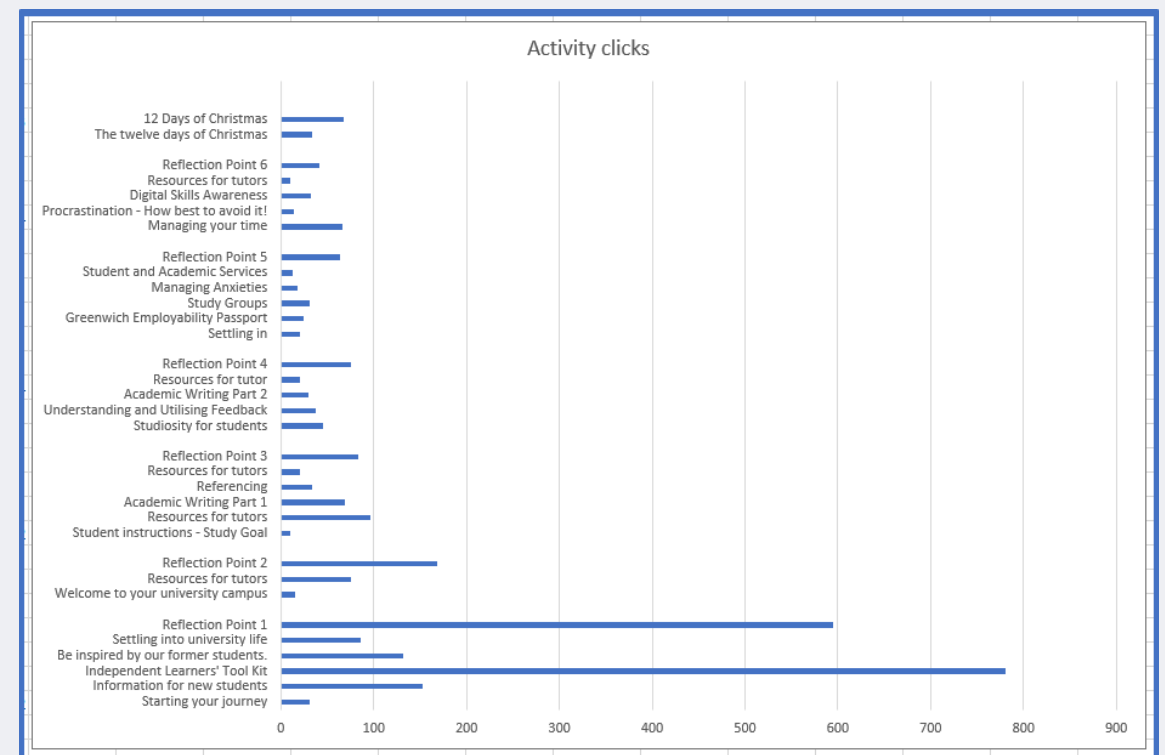
LEVELUP SUPPORTS STUDENTS IN KEY STAGES OF THEIR JOURNEY

To encourage good learning habits and independence through maintaining a consistent structure:

### 1. Prepare

Flipped learning activities to complete in advance of a seminar.

### 2. Engage

Tutor-led seminar/tutorial provides a platform for students to discuss and complete tasks. May be self-directed or used in peer-learning activities.

### 3. Reflect

Students take their learning to a higher level through research or application of skills learned. Students note their reflections in Reflection Point for a chance to earn a badge for the section.

### 4. Follow the arrows

After each session, signposts for students to engage in other university activities that enhance and build on their learning.
