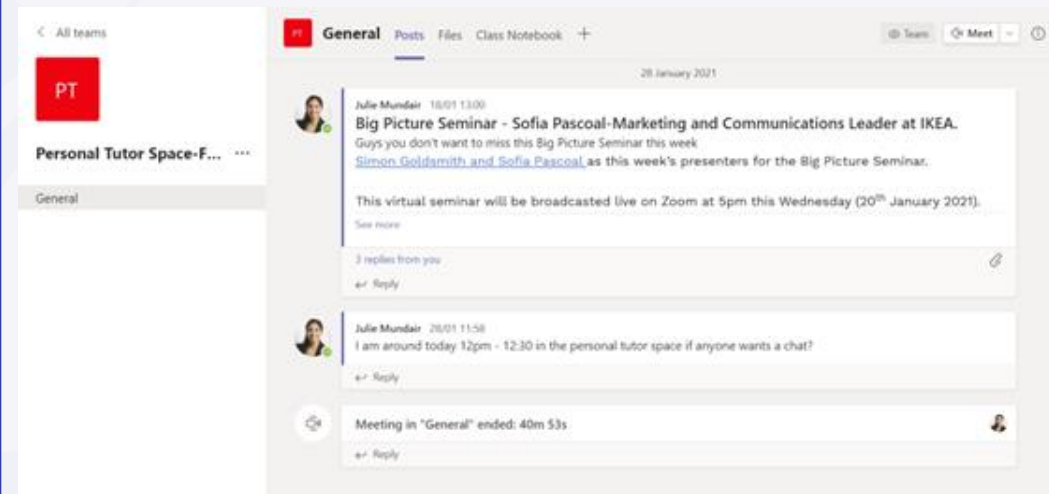
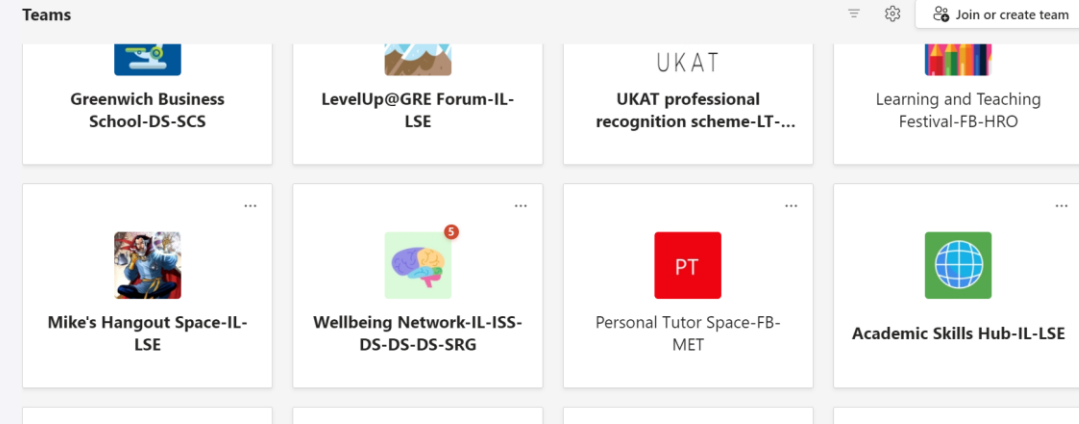
Group tutoring to shape independent learning
